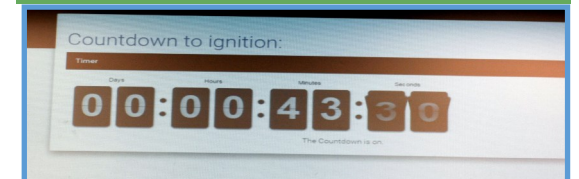

## Orange Team Members

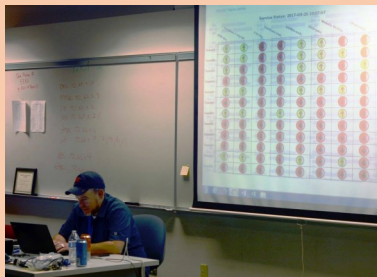
Would you like to help students understand the need for excellent customer service while following proper security protocols?
